Call Meeting to Order: Chairman Horlacher called the meeting to order at 7:00p.m.

Treasurer's Report. Treasurer Schulner read the September, 2020 Treasurer's report. We had a beginning balance of \$200,498.39, deposits of \$1,548.00, interest (.20%) \$34.08, withdrawals of \$28,839.05, leaving a balance of \$173,241.42. CD's are at \$17,737.85, \$8,658.33, and \$8,269.88. Savings accounts are at: Road equipment: \$69,243.70, Contingency \$56,299.48; Building \$25,981.67; Road Maintenance \$143,951.11; Forest Harvest \$6,650.00. Bill made a motion to approve the report, Ray seconded. Motion carried.

Pay Bills: Randy Horlacher made a motion to pay the bills, Bill Ruff seconded. Motion carried.

Citizen Discussion on Agenda Items: None

Pavilion: Looking at power, one estimate was \$2,200 to have power company bring it in. We will look at other options with private electrician. Talked about the issue of trucks parking – need to put up a sign indicating no parking. Bought a security system to put up at the hall and facing pavilion.

Tiny House: Randy had a discussion with EC City/County Health Dept. Requested they revoke permit. Waiting for a response from them. We will probably need to pursue this legally.

Signage: Derrick received bid from the State for new Ludington signs. It was suggested to contact the Fall Creek Schools for a quote on signs – the students are involved in making the signs. This maybe a good option for a new sign on the front of the building. The Board discussed on the color of signs – Blue and White.

New Business – The Board received a request to put a house on a lot in the subdivision off of Curler Road. It is only on a 1-acre parcel. It is unknown if there is room for a house, along with the existing shed and garage on the property. It was suggested that Fred be involved. He should look at the property and give an opinion.

Hall Rental – No hall rentals received.
